NM BRED QH & TB YEARLING SALES: horses must be “*Accredited New Mexico Bred*”, and have their papers stamped with the NM Bred Registration number in order to qualify for these sales. The New Mexico Horse Breeders Assn. determines eligibility for registration and now allows all horses, whether named or unnamed, to have their papers stamped with a registration number. (Information can be obtained by calling 505-262-0224 or from their website: nmhorsebreeders.com) These horses are accepted on a first come-first serve basis, so early consignment is important to assure acceptance. Stalls *are* limited.

SELECT BROODMARE SALE: this sale is limited to 60 QH broodmares. Selection will be made after review of the pedigree with final selection approximately one month after deadline.

SELECT YEARLING SALE: these consignments are accepted or rejected after review of pedigree and conformation by a selection committee. Preference is given to those horses entered in the Triple Crown series of races. Final selection occurs approximately one month after deadline. Consignors are notified if their entry is rejected; registration papers are returned and consignment fees are refunded.

SALE TIMES: All sales will start after the close of live racing each day.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fees are as shown above. Late fee of \$50 charged for payment after deadline.

All fees are due at entry unless they are to be held from Sale proceeds. If held from proceeds, the *Registration Certificate* must accompany the consignment documents at time of entry, no exceptions.

Fees are due in full if animal is withdrawn after the deadline; the exception being that the animal becomes unfit for sale. A written veterinarian’s statement certifying the reason for unfitness is required. Sale management

will review the statement and determine what portion of the fee, if any, can be refunded. If the animal is withdrawn *after* catalog preparation is underway, June 1 for all sales, a minimum of 50% of entry fee remains due.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

AT TIME OF ENTRY submit the following:

Completed, signed **Consignment Form**.

Original "Parentage-Verified" **Registration Papers** must be received in our offices no later than 21 days prior to the Sale. If registration is pending at time of entry, submit a copy of the **Registration Application**. No horse may enter the sale ring unless the original Registration Papers are on file in the Sales Office. (A copy is **required at time of entry** if animal is registered.)

Check your papers for accuracy of markings, description, etc! If, after inspection by our sales crew, it is determined that the papers are in error and a **Corrected Certificate** must be submitted to the breed association for issuance of a corrected certificate, a fee of \$125 for AQHA and \$150 for The Jockey Club will be deducted from seller's sale proceeds for preparation, handling & postage, and breed association fees. If the animal is repurchased, fees will be reduced by 50%.

For Broodmares in foal or with foal at side: **Breeder's Certificate**. Complete the form below and enclose with consignment documents. Consignments of pregnant mares and/or unregistered weanlings will not be accepted without a Breeder's Certificate on each, included with consignment documents at time of entry. (This form can also be found on the AQHA Registration Application.)

A completed, signed, **AQHA Transfer Report** for Quarter Horses. These reports have to be accurate; erasures or strike-outs are not allowed. Forms are available online from AQHA's website. Please include your AQHA ID number; it is a great aid in expediting the Transfer.

UPON ARRIVAL OR PRIOR TO SALE submit: it is necessary to travel with original Health & Coggins, so please submit a copy as soon as available, originals to be submitted upon arrival. Faxed copies are acceptable.

For Broodmares: A veterinarian's **Certification of Pregnancy or Barren Condition** dated no earlier than 10 days prior to the Sale. The Sale Veterinarian can provide this service if not done before arrival.

Health Certificate dated no earlier than 10 days prior to Sale due in Sales Office.

Negative **Coggins** dated no earlier than 6 months prior to Sale; copy due in Sales Office as soon as available.

If these documents are not received in a timely manner a \$100.00 late fee will be assessed.

HIP NUMBERING: (☺ Coffee & Donuts will be served!)

Select QH Yearling & Broodmare Sale: Hip numbering will be conducted by a random draw in the Sales Pavilion on July 2(Rainbow Futurity Trial day) at 8:00am. As in past years, one hip number exchange is permissible within this owner's entries. Hip numbers will be posted on our website within two days after the draw, or the good news can be obtained by calling the office. ***All requests for hip number exchanges **must be submitted in writing** and received no later than July 16.

NM Bred TB & QH Yearling Sales: Hip numbers are also assigned by random draw, using the same method as the Select Sale, to be drawn May 25. One hip number exchange is permitted in these sales also; requests must be submitted in writing no later than June 8.

STALL ASSIGNMENTS: Stalls assignments will be finalized approximately two weeks prior to each sale. Special requests must be in writing and in our office 30 days prior to the Sale. The stalls will be ready 4-5 days prior to the Sale. They will be adequately bedded once by the Sale Co.; any additional bedding will be the responsibility of the consignor.

STALL CARDS: Stall Cards will be provided at no charge and installed by the Sale crew. Please notify the Sales Office when consigning your entries if you **do not** require sale company stall cards.

CATALOGS: The wording of the top line in the catalog is taken from the "consigned by" line on the *Consignment Form*, so fill it out exactly as you wish this line to appear in the catalog.

UPDATES: All updates must be in writing. (Forms are available from sale website, the catalog, or sale office.) Updates for *inclusion* in the catalog need to be submitted no later than 60 days prior to the Sale. Updates requested after that time will be *announced* at the sale if received no later than 2 hours prior to the Sale.
Updates for *race performance*: consignor must provide copies of chart information available from AQHA or the Jockey Club.

ENGAGEMENTS: Accuracy of the engagements shown in the catalog is extremely important. If sustaining payments have not been made, the published Engagement is no longer valid and a correction needs to be made in the form of an announcement at the Sale.

PROOF PAGES: can be obtained from Robin Glenn Pedigrees by calling 405-262-3244 for a small fee. If the animal was unregistered at time of entry, the catalog page is especially subject to error. It is the Consignor's responsibility to verify the ***accuracy*** of all information shown in the catalog and to notify the Sales office of any errors, omissions, or changes. An announcement correcting the item will be made during the Sale.

Catalogs will be mailed, one per address, approximately 3-1/2 weeks prior to each Sale. A limited number of catalogs will be available at the Sale, so please bring your copy.

The **Special Notices** and **General Information** pages at the front of the catalog give details of the requirements and the conditions of sale.

LIVESTOCK INSPECTION: The New Mexico Livestock Board requires a hauling permit to legally haul livestock within the State of New Mexico. The Board provides the inspector who will be in attendance at the sale to issue the necessary hauling permits.

EXOGENOUS ANABOLIC STERIODS: Consignor's warrant that their entry has not been administered any exogenous anabolic steriods(EAS) by signing the Consignor's Contract. The **Limited Warranty** is as follows:

LIMITED WARRANTY

CONSIGNORS warrant that any yearling entered in the Ruidoso Horse Sales(RHS) shall not have been administered any Exogenous Anabolic Steriods (EAS).

In order for purchaser to avail himself of this **Limited Warranty**, purchaser agrees to pay \$500.00 to RHS to cover direct costs and administrative expenses in regard to the blood sample being taken. RHS will then arrange for the sale veterinarian to obtain a blood sample to be taken to be sent to a laboratory selected by the RHS for testing for EAS. Should the post sale test reveal the presence of EAS at such a level as determined by the testing laboratory that shows that EAS is present in the system of the horse(positive test), the purchaser shall have the right to rescind the sale of the horse, which rights must be exercised by the purchaser giving notice to RHS within 24 hours of the purchasers receipt of the results of a positive test. If purchaser elects to rescind the sale as the result of a positive test for EAS, the RHS will refund the purchase price paid by the purchaser which has been held from the consignor pending the results of the blood test. RHS will give notice of the results of such test to the consignor and purchaser as soon as practical after receipt of test results are received from the testing laboratory which is anticipated to be within 10 days of the date of sale. In addition, neither the purchaser nor consignor shall have the right nor shall RHS have any obligation to conduct testing of split sample. RHS decision concerning whether there is a positive test as long as same is supported by the testing laboratory selected by RHS shall be fully binding upon the consignor, purchaser and all other interested parties. In the event any party challenges RHS exercise of discretion, absence of fraud or bad faith such party shall be liable for all of RHS reasonable expenses, including without limitation its attorney fees incurred in defending the challenge. Pending the outcome of the test results the purchaser shall be responsible for all expenses including, but not limited to, such items as \$500.00 testing fee, veterinarian charges, vanning, insurance, and boarding. Purchaser will be required to exercise due care during the recession period in maintaining and boarding the horse. The purchaser shall not cause the horse to be materially altered during the recession period.

In the event of a positive test, risk of loss shall remain with purchaser from the fall of the hammer until the consignor has been notified of purchaser's election to rescind the sale at which time risk of loss passes back to the prior owner. The prior owner shall remain responsible for paying the standard commission and fees, based upon the gavel price, as indicated on the *Consignor's Contract* and for the testing fee, veterinarian charges, vanning, insurance, boarding, and any other expenses incurred while buyer waited for the test results.

Upon the recommendation of the Scientific Advisory Committee of RCI, RHS will use the 25pg/ml plasma level for quantification as a basis for a positive test, which means an effective ban on using any of the four anabolic steroids, Testosterone, Stanozolol, Boldenone and Nandrolene, recommended withdrawal times are as follows: (Testosterone-28 days), (Stanozolol-49 days); Boldenone-130-140 days) (Nandrolone-49 days). Please pay special attention to the type of medication used when determining the withdrawal time. In the event that generic anabolic steroids are being used, the withdrawal times may vary.

EVA: Not required.

SUSTAINING PAYMENTS: Buyers can verify the status of sustaining payments on Futurity & Derby nominations by calling the Nominations Secretary, Annelle Reynolds, at 575-378-4431.

A **Sustaining Payment** form and **Payment Schedule** can be found in the catalog and on RHS website. The buyer is responsible for notifying the Nominations Secretary of new ownership. The Buyer's Package will contain a form that can be completed and mailed or FAXed to the Nominations Secretary notifying her of the new ownership name, address, etc....
